

All right. We're off and running on the kingdom of God. The light is green. Who keeps telling you it's red? So I want to get in here in the second part of this, and I want to start unpacking some of this. And so I laid a big foundation in the beginning. I'm not going to reiterate all that. You can go back and listen to the first module and you'll get the foundational scriptures. I laid out about eight or ten scriptures in three chapters in John. You've got enough information to read to decide for yourself if this is biblically founded or not. I overloaded you with scripture.

But what I want you to get is I want to talk a little bit about desire. See part of the way the father leads us. We've been taught by the light is red people that he's going to send you somewhere you don't want to go, and he's going to make you do something you don't want to do. Okay? That's not true. Period. He's fashioned you, and all the days for you, before you were born.

The word of God says that desire realized, and that where desire is de- of sire, father, of the father brings forth the tree of life. You do realize the tree of life is not in the garden anymore, but once you're born again it's in you. The tree of life, eternity. The father and the son and the holy spirit have taken their abode inside of you according to Jesus' prayer in John, chapter 17. So it shouldn't be an argument there.

Anyways, if they're in you, trust me, the tree of life is there. So this desire realized is actually the way the father makes us. In Psalms you'll see that he skillfully put us together in secret where no one could see it. He's seen us yet unformed being formed, and then it says there was substance in us. And that substance he highlighted to me and I believe that it is the DNA from the father put in us in secret.

And I believe within the DNA is a lot of things. But two things that we're going to hit is your innate gifting and your dreams. And I believe both of those are in that DNA. And so primarily the way the father leads is through what's already in your heart. See he had a plan for your life. I want you to get this, God had a dream. And he wrapped your body around it and put you on planet Earth. And in that process, he put a certain type of gifts and talents inside of you to accomplish what you and him would do together.

That's his plan, is that you and him would do together. That's his plan, is that you and him would go as sons and daughters with him in a journey of living your life here on planet Earth, and bring him glory. Remember what brings the father glory, that you bring forth much fruit. Much fruit means increasing your life through your life unpacking and unfolding like he fashioned it. Okay? This is not stretching that. That's what it means.

And so what I want you to get is he's glorified when you get your dreams. He's glorified according to ... read the whole three chapters from 14 all the way through 17. Four chapters, 14, 15, 16, and 17 of John. And it's like he's glorified. The word of God says he's glorified when you get answers to your prayer. Why would you pray for something you don't want? That would be number one. I don't. I normally, like my kids when they come see me, if they want something they just ask for it. That's what I do with the father because that's what he said. "Come and ask, the kingdom is yours."

It is the pleasure of the father to give you the kingdom. Jesus said this. This is written in Luke 12. 42, I think. And so he is interested in you getting the kingdom. The kingdom is everything. I mean the streets are paved with gold, people. So there's no lack of anything. All right. And if he was against wealth and you having a life here on Earth that was abundance, he wouldn't build his streets with gold, and build the temple up there, and the gates have like one giant

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pearl, each one of them. He wouldn't build heaven like that if he isn't interested in you living an abundant life here.

This is not a prosperity message. This is about you living out what's inside of you. See all you need is in you now because the teacher lives inside of you, and the teacher is the holy spirit. Period. Jesus said, I'm going to send a comforter, and he will teach you, and lead you, and guide you in all things.

If I don't leave, he can't come. Well, Jesus left. He sent the teacher. The teacher is here to teach you as a student. And then you pass the next test. And then on and on. The test is not hard necessarily. Although it might be hard like taking tests at school because you have to pass it. It takes you through a process of growing up where you can carry more glory.

See, the glory ... We were made to carry his glory. The word of God solidifies that in John, chapter 17. "The glory which you gave me, father, I now give them." Think about that. The very glory of the son of God, the Christ, the Messiah, that was given to him. He says, "Father, I now give them that same glory." Do you realize you have the glory of the Christ on you now, and in you?, according to Jesus' prayer, if you've been born again.

Okay. So this is like powerful. But we don't hear anyone talking about this. We hear people talking about the light's red and you have to ask for permission. I'm here to tell you the light's green and the father says, Yes, what was the question again? Because the word of God says the promises of God are yes and amen once you're in the finished work, which is in Jesus. And he's in you, and your son and daughter in the kingdom. The answer is yes. What was the question again?

And you said, well, the answer can't always be yes. Well the word of God says the answer is yes and amen to every promise in the word. Now how you work out your salvation and get the promises of the kingdom in your life is a different story, but they're already all available to you based on the word of God. He says, the answer is yes for all the promises, and it's amen, so be it.

All the promises of God are in the word, and you seek them out, and you learn to live out with the father your own relationship with him, and walk out your own salvation. And what you'll find is these promises will pop up and they'll be intricate in your life. And, yes, I realize that this is part of you growing up because in Galatians, chapter 4, verse 1, it says that as long as the servant, as long as the child who's heir to everything stay a child he's no more than a slave. Okay? But he's under mentors and tutors appointed by the fathers.

So if you stay immature the rest of your life and never grow up, you probably won't receive many of these promises, just like Paul talks about in Galatians, chapter 4. If you stay a child, even though you're lord of all, that's how the old King James says it, then you remain no more than a slave. Because you're lord of all but you don't know how to walk in it. So you have to realize there is a caveat in this. You have to learn how to walk out your own relationship with the father. But I'm here to tell you, the kingdom is yours because Jesus said so. I'm here to tell you desire realized is the tree of life and the word of God says so. And that the father has made you for desire.

He hasn't made you for harshness. He hasn't made you for restriction. He hasn't made you to be constrained. Jesus came to set you free. When you're set free ... The word of God says, Christ came to set you free for freedom's sake alone. This is the highest value in heaven in my opinion, is freedom. Because he wants you to have complete free will to either choose him or

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not. Walk with him or not. But I'm here to tell you, if you walk with him, if you have everything that the kingdom has, why on earth would you not walk with him? Hello? This is the point of the light is green. The answers are yes. What was the question again?

And so there is a caveat of you growing up. I do realize that. Grow up in Christ. You have to grow up in him. And so I'm putting that caveat in there so you don't just think that you can do whatever you want to do. If this is what you think I'm talking about, you missed the point to start with. Remember? Me and the father, and you and the father, are one now. So we walk out together. And when we walk the wrong way, he just tweaks us a little bit and bends us back the other way, and we follow him. Because he's the father. We're not. But he's in us and now we have his mind, the mind that was in Christ Jesus. Let it be in you, is what the word says. And through his mind, I have the mind of exactly what Christ would do. Hello.

And so I know this is fast, and I'm throwing it at you fast. But you can re-listen to it. And I'm trying to really still lay some foundation because I can feel the restriction against this teaching in the air right now. Because people don't believe this. Well this is why your identity is skewed and you don't know who you are, because you don't know who your daddy is. The moment you find out who your daddy is, and I'm talking about knowing him. I'm not talking about ... Most people mentally ascend to revelation in the word. And they say, "Oh, yeah. I believe in Jesus. I believe that the father loves me. I believe."

But you know what? When they get pressed they start getting on the floor and acting like they got to crawl through glass and do all the religious forms, ways, and traditions of men to get to the father. That is a lie from hell. Period. You do not have to do that. Let me tell you how easy it is. You just roll your eyes, and the father is there. That's the metaphor he gave me. Is like, when my children look at me and they roll their eyes, I melt like ice cream on a hot paved street in the summer when it's 100 degrees in the South. How fast is that? That's really fast. The ice cream is almost melted before it hits the pavement.

Let me tell you something. When my children look at me like that, and I look at the father like that, what do you think he feels? You think you're more righteous than he is? Read Matthew 7:11 until you get it. You're not, number one. You would never say that, but that's implication by the way you treat him based on the way your children look at you and you treat them. If you think you treat them better or differently than he would treat you, and you're a good parent ... Now if you're beating them, obviously I don't want you to correlate that with the father. But assuming there's a good relationship with you and your children, you understand that when they look at you, you just melt and you're a good father. I'm mainly talking to men but it would apply to women as well. And you just would do anything for them. Do you not think the father's like that? And if you don't, you're wrong.

Because the word of God say's he's right, not because of me. I'm not telling you wrong on my merit. I'm telling you you're wrong according to the word of God. And if you're going to argue with something, pick your Bible up and start arguing with him. Don't argue with me. This is just something that I found that set me free, and I want to give it away to set other people free.

It's not about rigid forms, rules, and ways. It's about relationship with the father. Hello. Jesus came that you might know the father. This is what he said. He said the reason I come into the earth is that you would know the father. That word "know" is that same word where Adam knew Eve. It's an intimacy with you and him. The word know when Adam and Eve was ... It's about intimacy, but it's [inaudible 00:11:26]. It's the sexual consummation of who they were. It's the closest connection we can understand. Our connection with God, when a man and a

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woman connect like that, but it's not sexual in nature with the father. It's just that's how tight he wants to be with us.

The difference between him and us is we can't tell when he begins and we end, and where we end. Because we're one with him, and he's one with us based on what Jesus said in John, chapter 17. And do realize that when you know the father, you have the [inaudible 00:11:53]. You're one with him. You're as close in intimacy as you're ever going to get. So let me tell you something. This is not about rules and regulations and principles. This is about relationship first. Relationship will cause your heart to be so in love that the things that you're supposed to do, you'll do out of joy, not out of being told you've got to do them.

Okay. I didn't say you could break all the rules. I said that there are things that the father has as standards and values, and we should do those. Okay? But that's not the way you get his heart. The way that we get his heart is through relationship first. So forgive my passion, or don't. Because this is who I am. And I am passionate about this because this has changed my life so much that I just want to give it away to people so they'll understand how good the father really is. He's ridiculously good. You can't even measure how good he is.

Above and beyond all you can ask and think, that's him. He's there. So anyways. We move on. Boy I can't get past the first entry of this because I keep feeling the restriction against this message in the air. And I know it's now you because you're listening to it in yet the future. But darkness doesn't want this to get out. Because all darkness has to do is when light hits it, it has to leave. But it's coming out.

So anyways. I regress. Let's start back with desire again. Now I'm going to go through it and we're going to end here in a few because I don't want this to be but so long. Desire realized is the tree of life. So I've kind of unpacked how we got here. And if you need to go back and listen to it, then go back and listen to it. But the father made you for desire. It is the pleasure of the father to give you the kingdom. So when I said he won't tell you where to go and what to do, because this is what we tell people .... He's going to tell you to go to Africa, and you don't want to go. He's going to tell you to crawl on glass, and you don't want to do it. Everything you don't want to do, he's going to make you do. That's a lie.

That's a lie. Now I will say this. Sometimes he calls us to things that we don't know we're equipped for and that is really in our heart. Because he hides things on purpose, of purpose, for us according to Ruth, where it says that the gleaners, when they were gleaning. Boaz told him, he said, Leave handfuls of purpose, not on purpose, but of purpose for her. In other words, leave stuff in the field for her to pick up.

Well, he hides things of purpose for you until you're ready for them. So sometimes he calls you to go to a place that you don't even realize you have a desire to go to. I've seen this with people. And then suddenly something happens. Maybe you visit. Maybe you see a picture of that place. And maybe it's a third world country and you're thinking, "I'd never go there." But that's what your head's saying. But one day you see something and something inside of you starts changing. And you're like, "What is this?" And then suddenly there's a desire that starts popping up. "I want to go there. I want to be there with those people. I want to live there."

I didn't say it was easy when you went. Because when you walk with the father, whether you're on Wall Street, or whether you're in the middle of Africa in the bush, and you're called to either one, there are still going to be problems. If you think there's not problems on Wall Street in Manhattan, New York, you're wrong. What you're called to, there's going to be problems. The only place there isn't problems is heaven. Hello.

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If you're on Earth, there's going to be issues. So sometimes God hides things of purpose, of his purpose of what he wants us to do until we're ready. And then the desire starts bubbling up and you end up going to Africa. You end up going. But my thing is that a lot of times we're taught that this is the automatic thing, that he tells you to do something you never want to do, and tells you to go somewhere you don't want to go. That is not in the word of God.

Now I didn't say that people weren't called to do unusual things, and they might not have thought that that's what they wanted. But I can tell you this. Their hearts start lining up with the father as they walk. You can read all the Old Testament accounts. You can read Jesus' account. You can read the disciples. And even Paul said, "I must go to Rome." And one of the prophets said, well ... He came and tied Paul's hands up and his feet up and said, "If you go, they're going to bind you." And Paul, said, "I know. I'm going to lose my life there." See Paul was called to be beheaded in Rome. Well, he knew it before the prophet told him they're going to bind you when you go.

So was that Paul's will? Did he have a desire to be beheaded? Well, probably not if he had a choice. But, see, he knew it was part of his makeup and call. And so he went, but he knew ahead of time. My point is this. You might go, but God might take you into some hard places. I'm not saying he won't. But I'm also saying this, that when preachers, or anyone tells you that God's going to send you somewhere you don't want to go, and going to make you do something your whole life you don't want to do, that's a lie. It ain't in the Bible.

So you have to find the balance in that, okay? Because religion is, remember who told you the light was red anyways? That's religion. That's not true Christianity. True Christianity is following Jesus. It's following the father. And I'll tell you what. You're going to be lit up when you follow him because his heart is going to match your heart, because remember in Psalms 139? He actually created you in secret, put substance inside of you. And he skillfully put you together and fashioned your life for you all your days before you were born.

And I'm going to tell you what. His desire is good for you. The light is green. And you might be just as happy ... I know people that are missionaries in India and Africa right now. And they are as happy as anyone living on Wall Street. Probably happier than most who have all the money in the world, drive the nicest cars, have any time they want to go away. They're happier in where they live in India and Africa because they're called. There's a purpose. There's a desire of the father. See?

And I know these people. And I've supported them financially because I don't want to go there. That's not my heart. My heart's to do what I'm doing now, to set people free. You might go to Africa, or India. Wonderful. I'm for it. Let me know because I like to support missionaries who go to places, who have a heart for that. But I have a heart for America, and that's my call, right? And my purpose. And so I'm doing what I'm called to do. I'm not saying people are not called to go to tough places. Look. America is a tough place if you ain't figured that out. Look at the backdrop of politics in our country right now if you don't think it's a tough place, and the way Christians are perceived.

So what I'm trying to get you to understand is that the whole theology of crawling over glass and having to do five to ten things to get to the father is not God. It's religion. And it's the people who told you, "The light's red and you need permission." That's not true. Once you are in Christ, you don't need permission. You already have complete access in Christ. Period. This is what the word of God teaches.

And so I want to balance the two, and that's why I brought up the former, because I do know missionaries that are over in countries you wouldn't want to go live in. And sometimes their life is at risk, like physically on a weekly or daily basis in these areas. So there are people called to that, but I can tell you their heart beats for it. Their desire for those people just keeps growing bigger and bigger. And when I see the ones from India, they come back, and when they come back we have dinner together. I know them personally. And man, they are beaming when they tell me about these people. They're beaming when they tell me how many children they rescued out of the dump and put in this school that they have. I mean, they're beaming. They're like fired up more the next time I see them than the time before. That's when you know it's desire of the father. And their heart beats for that country. That is wonderful. That's their dream.

This is my point. He leads you by desire and dreams, not rules and regulations. If you are led by his desire and dreams, you will fulfill the law. Like Paul said, if you being Jews don't do the law, but do opposite. And the people that are Gentiles who don't know the law, but yet do it out of their nature, they become a law unto themselves. This is what Paul's writing says. And so what happens is that when you walk out with the father, these dreams and desires, you want to do his values. His values naturally bubble up in you. And when your will is contrary to those, then you humble yourself just like Jesus did. And you do that which you know is right.

So I'm not saying there won't be a struggle in any area. But what I am saying is he doesn't lead by rules and regulations. He leads by desires and dreams. And if you'll just make that shift then you won't have a problem keeping the rules because they won't be rules anymore. They'll be, these are the values of the father and we're walking this out together, and I don't want to violate anything that will hurt him. You'll look at it like, if my children come in and say, I know dad's away and mom's away on vacation. And these are teenagers, and I know that their values is not to have a group of people over here and trash the house. So, you know, and people try to force them into doing it. And if they are children who really know the values of the father and mother, then they'll say, "You know what? We can't do that because this is not right." They don't do it out of me telling them about rules. They do it out of love for me and their mom, at our heart.

I do the same thing with the father. You will too because he's so good. But see, until you know he's so good, you won't do this. But you'll just go back and revert to the rules because you think you have to prove something to him to have access to him. And I'm telling you, when Jesus said, "It's finished." I don't understand what you don't get about it's finished. Because when it's finished you have complete access, and it is the father's good pleasure to give the kingdom to the children. And you be one of those children.

And so we're going to end here. And I hope I'm done with the second one, laying the foundation. Because I feel like that hopefully now I've got enough here that you won't resist the father's desire for your life. Hopefully module three we'll actually get into that. So we'll see you on the other side.

Go back and listen to these. Study the scriptures for yourself. Study all the thoughts that I'm giving you for yourself. Have your own insight on them. You don't have to believe what I say. Just go to the word of God. Please don't disagree with the word. I've given you probably 15 to 20 different scripture references and three chapters, four chapters in John to read yourself. That is plenty of foundation for what we're talking about.
